



## KENDALL APPLICATION STEPS

### 1. Application for Admission & Essay

Complete online application and essay

### 2. English Language Fluency Examination Results

Kendall College requires one of the following exams as proof of English competency for students that are non-native English speakers.

#### Test of English as a Foreign Language (Academic TOEFL)

Kendall's TOEFL Code 1366

- Internet-based TOEFL: 71 or higher with minimum subscores  
*All components must meet minimum level of 17.*

#### International English Language Testing Systems (IELTS)

- 5.5 with minimum subscores

*Speaking and listening: 5.5*

*Reading and writing: 5.0*

Applicants who do not meet Kendall's published English Proficiency requirements may be offered provisional admission. To be eligible for provisional admission, applicants must meet one of the following requirements:

#### Test of English as a Foreign Language (Academic TOEFL)

- Internet-based TOEFL: 64 - 70 with minimum subscores  
*All components must meet minimum level of 16.*

#### International English Language Testing Systems (IELTS)

- 5.0 with minimum subscores

*Speaking and listening: 5.0*

*Reading and writing: 4.5*

### 3. Official Documents

Official Secondary-School Transcripts, Marks Sheets or Ending Examination Results. Official High-School transcript with graduation date and, if applicable, Official College or University transcripts.

Please note: all transcripts must be translated into English and evaluated by a foreign credential evaluation service. Please ensure that the company is approved and recognized by NACES.

The Office of Admissions & Registrar's Office are the only offices that are authorized to accept official transcripts. Electronic official transcripts should be sent to [kendalladmissions@kendall.edu](mailto:kendalladmissions@kendall.edu) to be deemed official.

### 4. Official ACT/SAT Score Report or Kendall Assessment Exam

Kendall College requires all students who have graduated from High School within five years of their intended start date to submit ACT composite scores of 18 or greater or three-part SAT score of 1290 or higher.

Students who did not take the ACT or SAT exam, or who graduated more than five years from the intended start date, will be required to take an online placement exam prior to admission.

Applicants who do not meet the academic entry requirements will be required to take the Kendall College New Student Assessment as a part of the admission process.

## F-1 VISA APPLICATION STEPS

### Documents Required to Apply for Student Status (F-1 visa) and Receive your I-20 Once Admitted to Kendall College

- Provide proof that you or your sponsor has access to at least the minimum expenses for your studies.

Business Program: \$34,500 or higher  
Hospitality Program: \$40,500 or higher  
Culinary Arts Program: \$45,000 or higher

The total of your scholarships, grants and personal or sponsor funds must equal or exceed the minimum amount. This should be in the form of a bank statement or letter from a bank indicating that either you or your sponsor maintain a balance of at least the minimum amount.

#### • Completed Confidential Statement of Financial Support.

If you are receiving funds from a sponsor, this form should be completed by both you and your sponsor indicating that you have access to the minimum funds for your studies and other expenses.

#### • Copy of the passport identity page.

If presently in the U.S. on a student visa, you must also provide the following documents:

- Permission to Transfer Form from the current school of enrollment
- Copy of the current I-20
- Copy of the F-1 visa page
- Front and back copy of the I-94 Card
- Release of the SEVIS record

If presently in the U.S. on an exchange visitor visa, you must also provide the following documents:

- Copy of the DS-2019 Form
- Copy of the J-1 visa page
- Front and back copy of the I-94 Card
